As a 1994 graduate of Notre Dame, and a parent of 4 daughters currently attending Notre Dame schools, I am writing this letter on behalf of the Notre Dame Marian Club. I became a member of the Notre Dame Marian Club because Catholic education is so important to me and my family. The Marian Club was founded in 1991 for the sole purpose of providing tuition assistance to students who might not otherwise be able to attend Notre Dame High School. Since 1991, over \$1,00,000 in scholarship aid has been given to Notre Dame Jr/Sr High School students. During the 2023-2024 school year, over \$45,000 was awarded by the Marian Club to students who had financial need. The Marian Club relies on membership dues as well as the memorial brick project to fund our yearly scholarships.

The Marian Club Brick Paver Memorial to Our Lady of Notre Dame is located directly in front of Notre Dame Junior-Senior High School. Bricks may be purchased for \$100 per brick. The bricks can memorialize one or more individuals, a special event (Sports team, NJROTC, etc.), or be inscribed with a message to the school or classmates. A brick is a great way to honor an upcoming graduate of the class of 2024. Each brick can accommodate up to three lines of 18 characters per line with spaces counting as characters.
